Here's what you can expect from our veterinary team:

1 PRE-ANESTHETIC BLOODWORK

To verify your pet is a healthy surgical candidate



2 PAIN MANAGEMENT

To provide maximum comfort pre and post operation



3 MEDICAL MANAGEMENT

Catheter placement, fluid therapy, anesthesia monitoring



4 1:1 OBSERVATION

Supervised care with a technician from start to finish.

FOLLOW-UP CALL

Personal phone call to check on your pet the next day.

Neutering involves the removal of both testicles and offers significant long-term health benefits. Neutered dogs are less likely to exhibit behavior issues, and the procedure greatly reduces the risk of prostate disease while completely eliminating the chance of testicular cancer.
