WHAT TO EXPECT AT MOST SPAY/NEUTER CLINICS:

Your pet typically undergoes the procedure and is discharged a few hours later, often without pre-anesthetic bloodwork or post-operative check-ins.

PRE-ANESTHETIC BLOODWORK

To verify your pet is a healthy surgical candidate



PAIN MANAGEMENT

To provide maximum comfort pre and post operation



MEDICAL MANAGEMENT

Catheter placement, fluid therapy, anesthesia monitoring



1:1 OBSERVATION

Supervised care with a technician from start to finish



FOLLOW-UP CALL

Personal phone call to check on your pet the next day
